This day this cause came on to be heard on the papers formerly read and on material evidence &c. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree that Reynolds Deering late Sheriff and Executor of the estate of Thomas Harrison dec^d pay to John A. Davis the sum of thirty one dollars and fifty five cents with interest from 30th March 1856 till paid in full of last term against Thomas Harrison. The said Deering pay to Thomas Davis the sum of two hundred and fifty one dollars and twenty one cents with like interest in full satisfaction of last term against Thomas Harrison which sums constitute the balance due on last account rendered as administrators of Thomas Harrison. It is further ordered that Thomas Davis make return of Deering pay the costs of this suit on paper to the Court respectively decreed to them.
