Piper & Rogers are men of good character and that their store was placed for the neighborhood in which they were situated for the relief of several families.

Ordered that the overseer of the Poor have Margaret's Robert Riches children of Lebanon Riches four Negroes to Brewster & sufferer allowing to him that he pay nothing for their services until they amount to the age of ten years then pay the sum of ten dollars annually to be paid to the mother of the apprentices except for the last year which is to be paid to the apprentice.

AN Account Brewster's Commissioner Report of William S. Stephens administration on the estate of Henry Stephens is read returned and ordered to be set aside for exceptions.

ON Motion of Jonathan S. sufferer ordered that Thomas B. Merrill who is hereby appointed special Commissioner for the purpose state settle & adjust the said sufferer administration on the estate of Mary Whitfield as a matter report to Court with any matters deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

ON Motion of Just. Barnes ordered that Thomas B. Merrill who is hereby appointed special Commissioner for the purpose state settle & adjust an account of said Barnes territorial proceedings on the estate of George Whitfield as a matter report to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

ON Motion of William Barnes J. W. Merrill & John Vicks ordered that they and Saml. B. B. slaves belonging to William Vicks be exempt from the payment of taxes on premises they being aged and infirm.

ON Motion of Richard Johnson ordered that he be exempt from the payment of taxes on premises he being aged and infirm.
