Ordered that Jacob Brown & Jonathan Birrell do let to the local undertaker  
the refuse of the bridge over the brook, if Jacob Brown will send across the same  
when completed via Lake Report to Court.

Ordered that Robert Hickey Peter D. Buchanan's goods to the value of  
one hundred dollars be refused or returned if James Hickey carry the same  
across the same when completed & make Report to Court.

ON Motion of Joshua & Horrell B. & H. P. Pepe & eligible former Merchants in the  
Court the Court resolve that the said Joshua Horrell B. & H. P. Pepe & others are men  
of good character and that their stores are places fit & convenient for the neighbourhood in  
which they are situated for the retail of ancient spirits.

Ordered that the Owners of the Poor Land Margaret & Robert Hicks children of Robert  
Hicks four persons to Birrell & Sniffen according to law that her pay nothing for their  
services until they come to the age of ten years above pay the sum of one dollar annually  
to be paid to the Master of the apprenticeship for the last year which is to be paid to the  
apprentice.

ON Motion of Jonathan B. Sniffen ordered that Thomas B. Horrell who is being appointed  
special Commissioner for the purpose shall report the said Sniffen's administration on the  
estate of Henry Whitefield & make Report to Court with any matter specially stated  
deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

ON Motion of Jacob Brown ordered that Thomas B. Horrell who is being appointed special  
Commissioner for the purpose shall report the said Brown's territorial proceedings  
on the estate of George Whitefield & make Report to Court with any matter specially stated  
deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

ON Motion of William Birrell for Wm. M. Birrell ordered that they are given  
a bill of lading belonging to William Birrell for payment of taxes on furniture  
they being aged and inferior.

ON Motion of Richard Johnson ordered that he be exempted from the payment of taxes  
on furniture he being aged and inferior.
