Ordered that the account of William D. Smith Sheriff, amounting to five dollars thirty
and be certified to the auditor of public accounts for his remuneration & payment.

1810 Indorse of Joseph H. Barker & Daniel W. Drayton, who jointly purchased the
Sheriff's Office for the last year, by law given a greater time to keep house of final
settlement that to say the said Barker at the first House on the County and the said
Drayton at his house near Rockwell in this County, see May Court, next.

Anthony M. Howell who was appointed Constable at the last Court, this day took the
oath and was qualified by law and under Henry S. Smith, Treasurer of the County, he
received into a bond in the penalty of four thousand dollars conditioned in the law made,
which bond was acknowledged by the said Henry S. Smith, Treasurer and ordered to be recorded.

This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the
defendant has not kept notice of this notice then was solemnly called but came not.
Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff may have execution against
the defendant for the sum of twenty dollars & costs, law costs the property of said bond and
he costs by law shall be paid on the behalf of defendant and the said defendant or they go.
And the execution may be discharged by the payment of four dollars & fifty, ten cents with
interest from the 3. day of March 1816 till paid the costs.

The Commissioners appeared to view and Report to the Court the property of hunting

the road and bridge above mentioned and find that the small bridge lately out of use was
