Ordered that Henry D. Vaughan, James M. Parker and James Howell do let to the least undertaker the repair or rebuilding and such alterations as they shall deem proper, to the three small bridges on the south side of the river near Jessamine - across the same when enabled and make report thereof to the Court.
