On the motion of David Burroughs. Ordered that John J. Morris, who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose, shall take and adjust an additional account of said Burroughs' administration over Silas D. Barnes' estate and make report to the Court.

Ordered that the whole of Isaac J. Stevens' do be committed to the hands of Samuel H. Hunt of this County for administration according to Law.

An Inventory and Appraisement of the estate of Elizabeth Pope do now remain and ordered to be rendered.

On motion and for reasons appearing to the Court Alfred S. Stephenson is appointed Trustee in the name of William D. Stephenson in a certain debt of trust executed on the 17th day of October 1862 by John Morris to W. R. Stephenson for the benefit of William Stephenson and recorded in the State Office of this Court on the 1st of October 1863 with as full power as is vested in the said W. R. Stephenson by the aforesaid debt of trust.

On motion and for reasons appearing to the Court Alfred S. Stephenson is appointed Trustee in the name of Silas Summerville do in a certain debt of trust executed on the 19th day of May 1858 by John Morris to the said Silas Summerville for the benefit of Silas Vose and recorded in the State Office of this Court on the 5th day of June 1858 with as full power as is vested in the said Silas Summerville by the aforesaid debt of trust.

On the petition of William D. Stock administrator of Benjamin H. French et al. John B. Readings, Marmande H. Branch and John A. Hill and for reasons appearing to the Court the Court doth appoint Edwardsville Trustee in the name of Eli Baker in a certain debt of trust executed on the 26th day of January 1861 and recorded in the State Office of this Court by John B. Readings to the said Eli Baker for the benefit of the said H. D. Stock - man, reagent, Dr. John B. Readings, Marmande H. Branch and John A. Hill and that the said Eli Baker have the same power and authority as is vested in the said Eli Baker by the deed of trust aforesaid.

On the motion of Remond & H. Bedford. Ordered that Master Commissioner Colls examine this and settle an additional account of the said H. Bedford's administration over Henry J. May's estate and make report thereof to the Court with any written specially stated decree pertaining thereto or which he may be required to state.
