

On the motion of Albert S. Smith. Ordered that John H. Hurler make an account of his administration on William S. Smith's estate before William S. On the motion of James H. Hurler. Ordered that Charles Brown, former Clerk examine the said estate and make report thereon to the Court with any matters specially stated demand produced by himself or which may be required to be so stated.

Ordered that William Brown and Oliver Brown let to the Court certificates of the affairs of the bridge, and the head of Adams mill pond, across the same where completed and make report thereon to the Court.
