

On the motion of Abbott & Bent - Ordered that John H. Gentry make an account of his administration for the purpose, and that the said Commonwealth examine State & settle the last account of each of the above & the Court.

On the motion of Peter Jones, for myself. Ordered that Peter Gentry be diminished to the next Court a new cause, viz: the Indictments leading Sally Anne and others against four children of the late Peter Jones, to the said Gentry should not be succeeded.

Show account current and Commonwealth report of James Bell's administration on Penruddell Bell's estate together with the receipts filed thereon or else day to day account. Approved for reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that the said account be remitted to William D. Gardner who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose, and that the said Commissioners examine, settle and settle the said account and make report to the Court with any matters specially stated therein pertinent by himself or which may be required by either of the parties to be stated.

James Willeford is appointed Surveyor of the road from the foot of the hill at Sandford to Oldbury Swamp bridge in the road of Beaufort County named, and it is ordered that the usual bonds do make therewith.

Peter D. Beckman is appointed Surveyor of the road from Riddleboro Creek end to the Saylors bridge in the road of Joseph D. Beckman named, and it is ordered that the usual bonds do make therewith.

Thomas Heron Jr. is appointed Surveyor of the road from Beaufort Mills' side to George and the son of Henry Bellamy etc, and it is ordered that the usual bonds do make therewith.

On the motion of James Magill. Ordered that Master George Jones Bell examine, state and file an account of said Magill's administration on John Penruddell estate and report the same to the Court with any matter specially stated herein pertinent by himself or which may be required to be stated.

Ordered that William Orms and Oliver Bryant set to the Court immediately the repairs of the bridge, across the head of Allens mill pond, examine the same when completed and make report thereof to the Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
