Bridge & other repairs at Mafordings Mill recd by us to report that the said work
is completed according to contract and received by us. The contractor having been allowed by
Mills & Sumner at One hundred and thirty three dollars and twenty five cents as previously
reported to you today August 29th 1858 At T. Smith's I. Marcy Richard Bassett.

This day this cause came on again to be heard in the papers formerly used and used
argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth order, adjudge and decree that
Amy Purvis and Nancy Purvis be apprised of themselves - that they offer or do allow
of time and place of sale till on a writ of six months the land and negroes held
by Sally Woodard as done in the estate of her husband John Woodard - that the said lots
as follows after deducting the cost of the record which they are to receive in cash on the day
of sale - to wit - for the real estate they are to take four lots and apprize me to Benjamin
Worrell and Nancy his wife - one to Nathaniel Jones Escutier of Albany Jones who was apprized
of Anthony Woodard. One to John Purvis getting his wife - one to Sam'l Purvis son of
Samuel Woodard. One to William D. Clarke trustee for Daniel Fells one to the heirs of
Cain Woodard and the other to the heirs of Sept' Woodard. For the personalty they are to
take seven loads and apprise me to Jacob Purvis apprizer of Benjamin Worrell. One to Nathan
J. Jones Escutier of Albany Jones who was apprized of Anthony Woodard. One to Joseph Purvis
Executor of Joseph J. Claude whom apprized of Anthony Woodard who was apprizer of a long time
One to Sam'l Purvis son of J. Woodard - one to William D. Clarke trustee for Daniel
Fells. One to Mills & Lawrence and William D. Whitehead apprizers of Cain Woodard
and the other to the administrator of Sept' Woodard. That said Commissioners be duly authorized
to return in their hands funds sufficient to satisfy and pay the cost of keeping the negroes
and the parties are directed to make to the representatives of John Woodard a refunding bill
of he should demand the same. And said Commissioners are required to report their findings
in the Court in order to a final decree -
