Schell and Howard Vaughan have been credited to all the debt in land and slaves belonging to the estate of George A. B. Buchanan dec^d in the following amount: Of three hundred and ninety four acres of land (well enclosed) valued at three hundred and fifty nine dollars. 1000 all to Mrs. Hannah M. Cole one hundred and twenty five acres, valued at three hundred and eighty one dollars and thirty four cents as her share in the said land estate. Of nine negro slaves valued at twenty three hundred and twenty five dollars being one third of the value of the whole as her share in the share of said estate, all of which are respectively returned to the consideration of your Honors. 172 acres (all well enclosed) valued at 159.00
