 failed to meet) and was heard by Council. Whereupon the Court gave order that the said John
 receive fifteen lashes on his bare back well laid on at the public whipping post. And the Court
 gave sentence of this judgment to be done forthwith and then discharge the Prisoner from custody-

Richard M. Schell Coroner of this County appeared in Court and refused longer to discharge
 the duties of the said Office and desired his resignation to be taken of record.

On motion of David Daniels. Ordered that Master Commissioner Coll assume State Hall
 on account of said Daniels guardianship of Rebecca Stephenson and make report thereof to the
