On the motion of David Bryant who made oath and together with John Edwards and James Pennington his associates entered into and acknowledged and a bond in the sum of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs testifies that he obtained letters of administration on the estate of Matthew Gray deceased in due form.

Ordered that Jonathan Darden, Dennis P. Howell, Seabell Ellsworth and Remond Powell carrying three of them being sworn before a justice of the peace for that purpose do apprise all the personal estate of Matthew Gray deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court

I am a negro man slave belonging to Mr. Silvan Price of this County who hath been committed to the jail of this County charged with stealing goods (having appeared) to the amount of \$22 was this day set to the bar in custody of the jailor of this Court (the Court summing up his trial being failed to meet) and was heard by Counsel. Whereupon the court doth order that the said slave receive fifteen lashes on his bare back well laid on at the publick whipping post. That the Clerk cause execution of this judgment to be done forthwith and then discharge the prisoner from custody.

Audubon M. Seabell Counsel of this County appeared in Court and refused longer to discharge the duties of the said Office and desired his resignation to be entered of record.

On motion of David Powell. Ordered that Master Commissioner Coll remain State Hills as agent of said Powell's guardianship of Barbara Stephen and make report thereto in bond with my seal specially stated demand payment by himself or whosoever may be required to him.
