And make up of these proceedings to the Court.

The Report of Remonstrance held by Henry Morris treasurer as guardian of Nelson & son's executors on this day to be heard and was heard by Committee. On consideration whereof it is ordered that the said report and account be sent back to the remonstrator who reported it with direction to repeat it to the people of the executors estate. In what amount was expended for the personal expenses of the ward - and do expenses incurred for the support of the negroes including them the sum paid physicians for medical services rendered -
