day came the plaintiff by her attorney and the defendant not appearing to reply the attached
affidavit, it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recovers against the defendant the amount
due of \$10.00. Now due her provided to be paid and her costs by her in this behalf expended. And it
is ordered that the Sheriff make sale of the attached effects aforesaid according to law and
out of the moneys arising from such sale first pay and satisfy a prior judgment this day
rendered against the said Joseph Row in favor of B. C. W. P. P. then apply the balance
if any, or so much thereof as is necessary to the payment of this judgment and return the surplus
if any to the defendant. And return an account of said sale to Court.

On the return of Nothing M. Howell who made oath and together with James L. Mac-
kewary, her security entered into and acknowledged a bond on the penalty of two hundred
dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted her for Having letters of
administration on the estate of Mary Edwards dec'd on due form.

Ordered that John Morris Jr, Richard Darrith and William V. Edwards being
first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do apprise all the persons
of the estate of Mary Edwards dec'd and return the appointment under their hands to Court.

An account of Cozen Vicks administration on Samuel Vicks estate and of his executor-
ships of the affairs of said Samuel Vicks was returned and referred to be on form for
exceptions.

Ordered that William A. Sparks, Oliver Darden and Richard Darrith or any two
of them let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the bridge near Hammersmith near the
barren where completed and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that William A. Sparks, Simon Murfee and Richard Darrith or any two of them
view the bridge lately built across Hammersmith mill race and let to the lowest undertaker the
repairs as they may deem necessary, return the same when completed and make report thereof to
the Court.
