This Court adjourned. To be heard of the goods and chattels of the defendant in the hands of the agent administered. And the said defendant in attorney of record.

Sister & H. Davis presented. Mrs. Davis Alfred Banks, Rivers of Butler, H. D. Moore, Shadrack, Pate, Mr. Arthur, Penruddick, Lewis, John Evans, Collier, Estlin, Armstrong, Parker, Bill, D. Rockville, George Crump, Hollis B. Sommerville, Josephine Hayes and Josephine B. Davis were from a grand jury of eight report the alibi of this County and having recited their charge, withdrawn and after due time returned into Court and having nothing to present were discharged.

Ordered that William Davis, William H. Dodge, John Dowdy and David Davis, any three of them, let to stand as next after the expense of a Notary Public - receive the documents completed and make report thereof to the Court.

The Registers of Henry Turner, Jordan Wesley, Robert Wesley and Emily Garrison for record, were examined and certified to be truly made.

In regard offering to the Court. It is ordered that the Officers of the Poor have now \$1000 & Ephraim and Gates four miles back to George Crump according to law and that the said Crump pay for the services of the said officers as follows - for poor Ruthbury ten dollars annually - for Ephraim seven dollars annually and for Gates ten dollars annually - which is to be paid to the Officers of the Poor except for the last year apprenticeship which is to be paid to the apprentices respectively.

Ordered that the amount of General H. Davis Sheriff amounting to \$3.55 cents be deducted to the credit of Public accounts for his examination and payment.

The Court are unanimous in recommending Joseph H. Davis, William Briggs and Jacob Bond Court to the Governor of this Commonwealth as fit and proper persons to constitute the Office of Sheriff of this County the ensuing year.

This day the cause was debated and by consent came on to be heard on the bill, answer rights, law, facts and exhibits and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth say, order and decree that William J. Hobell, Rivers, A. Parker, Robert Banks and John Dowd, any three of whom may act, who are lawfully appointed Commissioners for the purpose, do after and twenty days notice of the time and place of sale, by advertisement at least once published in the neighborhood of the land, sell on the premises to the highest bidder, in a order of funds, securities, except cash sufficient to cover the expenses of sale and of this date, the land of which Daniel Williams died seized holding from the grantee three rods of several amounts with good security that they appear on record lands to Rebecca Briggs, one to Martha Williams and to Martha Williams, James & Lucy Ann Stevens to be paid to their legally qualified guardian - that the Commissioners make report in order to a final decree.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning ten o'clock.
