On the motion of James Barnes. Ordered that Alexander Myrick, Thomas B. Worrell and Jacob Barnes or any two of them who are hereby appointed Special Commissioners for the purpose, state, settle and adjust an account of the said Barnes' transactions in the estate of Burwell Everett dec'd and make report thereof to Court.

On motion of Martha Vaughan administrator of Anthony Vaughan dec'd. Ordered that William W. Thorne one of the Commissioners of this Court shall see account of the said Martha Vaughan administrator over her intestate estate and make report thereof to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

SamuelHello who has been appointed Commissioner of the Revenue for Newbury Parish in this County for the ensuing year, this day with John W. Farley his surety entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded.

On motion of William A. Mayfield. Ordered that Meredith Holland administrator of Victor Eley dec'd pay to the said William A. Mayfield the sum of twenty dollars the amount of his account found to be just.

A Writing bearing date October 19th 1864 purporting to be the last Will and Testament of Clements Rockelle dec'd was this day produced in Court by William A. Sparks the testator therein named in order to be proved. Whereupon George W. Conings who intermarried with a daughter of the said Clements Rockelle appeared in Court and opposed the proof of the said writing and thereupon William A. Sparks and James Mayot whose names are subscribed as witnesses to the said writing were sworn and examined and the parties by their Counsel fully heard. On consideration whereof it is the opinion of the Court that the Clements Rockelle deceased at the time of executing the aforesaid writing was of sound and disposing mind and memory and that he was under no undue influence and that the said writing was duly attested according to law. Whereupon it is ordered that the said writing be recorded as and for the last Will and Testament of the said Clements Rockelle dec'd. And on the motion of William A. Sparks the Executor thereon named who made and together with John R. Burley, Nathaniel J. Williams and James A. Mayfield his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One hundred thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certifying to granted him for retaining a portion of the said will in his hands.

Ordered that James Mayot, Avery Blow, Alexander Myrick, Thomas B. Worrell, Davis Bryant and Jacob Blenkhorn or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose, do appear at the personal estate of Clements Rockelle dec'd and return the appurtenant under their hands to Court.
