This day this cause came up again to be heard by account of parties upon the premises formerly recd
and was argued by Bernard. The residential sheriff the Clerk did adjudge order and decree
that James W Parker, Lewis Morell and Amos Stephenson who are hereby appointed Commissioners
of the Court, shall within thirty days from the date of this decree the said above named Commissioners
decreed to make a just and equal partition of前述 negro slaves belonging to the estate of
Alexander Pope dec'd remaining since the assignment of the same down to right equal parts
that they appear one part to James Pope, one part to Madison Pope, one to Oswald Pope, one
to Collins Pope, three parts to David Barrett guardian ad litem of Richard, Ames and Shepard
Pope and one part to Richard Barrett as guardian ad litem of Ernest Pope - and of said Com-
missioners cannot make a just and equal partition of such slaves as kind they are hereby authorized
and directed to make without public auction of me or any of said negroes, after having given due
and proper notice of the time and place of sale in order to effect the same - And that the said
Commissioners report their proceedings to Court in order to a final decree.

On the motion of Horatio Harris. Ordered that one of the Commissioners of the Court nominate, state
and settle an account of said Harris' administration on the estate of James Myrick dec'd and report
the same to the Court with any mutual specially stated demand presented by himself or which he
may be required to state.

On the motion of Joshua Wright. Ordered that the unadministered estate of Robert D Marquardt
dec'd be committed to the hands of Samuel B Horne Sheriff of this County for administration according
to law.

On the motion of Thomas D Morell. Ordered that Jack Barnes and Alexander Myrick do
state settle and adjust said Morell's administration on James George above and make report thereon
to Court -

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that Elizabeth Coffey widow of Henry Coffey dec'd who
was trustee for Polly Smith & children pay into Court the balance due as appears by Commissioner's bill
report, this day returned, from said trustee -

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that the Sheriff of this County take into his keeping
the negro slaves Stephen, Lucy and her seven children lately held by Henry Coffey as trustee
for Polly Smith and children and have them sent forth to Health until the further order of the
Court.

On the motion of Jack Williams who made oath and together with Philo & Cloud and Lawrence
Pope his witnesses certified and acknowledged a bond in the sum of five hundred dollars
conditioned as the same recd the certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on
the estate of Calathus M'Nails dec'd in due form.

Ordered that George Miller, George Williams, Oliver Daniels and Mills Pope or any three of
them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appear all the
