The Commissioner in this cause this day made the following report to the Court. "I presented & agreed to the aforesaid decree and recommended on the premises at public auction on the 1st day of January 1844 the tract of land belonging to the estate of Victor Hey de' when was sold James Massey became the purchaser for the sum of \$420. Costs paid \$2.74. Taxes for 1843 on \$420. 2.10. Balance due from J. Massey on 1st July 1843 \$27.16. Interest on \$27.16 from 1st July 1843 to 16 Dec 1843 \$22.74p. Amount now due from J. Massey \$27.94p. This said amount has been received by me and in pursuance of the decree I will now pay it into Court. All of which is respectfully submitted. Meredith Holloway - Dec. 16 1843. The Commissioner paid into Court the sum of \$27.94 subject to the order of the Court.
