The Commissioners in this cause this day made the following report: "We declined to enter interlocutory decree pronounced at Southampton September Court 1844 in the case of Abner Edwards against John Williams, Spikes Deale, Nelson B. Gardner, George Camp Jr. & J. R. Edwards ad litem to Jane, Nancy Fanny & Thomas Camp. At the undersigned being appointed Special Commissioners for the purpose, after having advertised as directed by the decree, at the Court house and at other places in the neighborhood of the land mentioned in the decree for thirty days previous to the day of sale, did on the 24th day of October 1844 on the premises dispose of the aforesaid land at auction on a credit of nine months, and Anthony M. Howell became the purchaser. Your Commissioners then proceeded to take down bonds as directed by the decree and to pay the same over to the parties interested as follows.
