John Cobb is appointed surveyor of the road from the forks near Colliers mill bridge to Buffins bridge in the room of John Linmons esq. And it is ordered that the usual bonds do work thereon.

James A. Gebrell is appointed surveyor of the road from Junction to the forks of the road at Colliers place in the room of Benjamin Bowey. And it is ordered that the usual bonds do work thereon.

On motion of Hanson J. Morris guardian of Eliza June. Army of Northern Virginia. Ordered that he be permitted to use twenty dollars each of the principal of the world's cities for their support.

The Registers of Charles Biggs, Nancy Charity, and Phoebe Williams, free negro, are examined and certified to be truly made.

On motion of William J. Gebrell Deputy of William L. Eschell late Sheriff of this County leave is given him to record his account made upon and caution paid out of this book on the 18 day of October 1842 in favor of A. M. Howell against Daniel Fowler. And therewith the said Gebrell accounted his return by making the word "Satisfied"; and inserting no less thereof the words "No effect".

Ordered that the court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
