The Commissioners in this cause this day made their report, which is in these words: "Pursuant to the annexed Cobb v Cobb. pronounced by the County Court of St. Asaph at the December Term 1844. your Commrs have allotted and set apart to the plaintiff Mary Cobb, as and for her dower for life, in the lands of which her late husband James Cobb dec'd. seized & possessed, one equal third part thereof as follows: all that part of said lands lying on the each side of the road leading from South Quay to Morris Ferry adjoining the lands of Matthew W. Vaughan, Cape Cobb & others, and bounded on the West by said road with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, with the privilege to rail timber and fuel &c on any other part of said lands where most convenient, for her own individual use - Respectfully Submitted Given under our hands the 21st day of Dec. 1844. Wm M Jones. M. W. Vaughan James Wells."

Ordered that John A. Person, Peter Edwards, John Whitehead and William L. Everett or any three of them with the Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Grunsilla do let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Hailys bridge: finish the same when completed and make report thereof to Court -

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County pay Hunt Drums Esqr. two hundred and fifty one dollars seventy nine cents, being this Countys proportion for repairs of Hailys bridge.
