The Commissioners in this cause this day made their report, which is in these words: "Pursuant to the amended Cobb & Cobb pronounced by the County Court of St. Amington at the December Term 1844. your Commttee have allotted and set apart to the plaintiff Mary Cobb, as and for her dower for life, in the lands of which her late husband Garrison Cobb died, seized & possessed, one equal third part thereof as follows: all that part of said lands lying on the each side of the road leading from South Quay to Monroe Ferry adjoining the lands of Matthew W. Vaughan, Gapse Cobb & others and bounded on the West by said road with all the appurtenances therunto belonging) or in any wise appertaining, with the privilege to rail timber and fuel &c on any other part of said lands where most convenient, for her own individual use - Respectfully Submitted Given under our hands the 21st day of Decr. 1844.
