against

This day this cause was heard by leave of Court and certain officers and came on to be heard on the bill and answer, and was argued by counsel: The Court ordered that the Court doth order, adjudge and decree that Henry Moore be appointed Commissioner of this Court, for the purpose of selling the mill known as Jacksons, the property of the late John Womack, upon such credit as may be hereunto best: that out of the proceeds of sale he first satisfy and pay the costs of this decree then pay the balance due in account of the purchase of the mill; and the balance of any proceeds the credit of the estate. And report to the Court in order to a final decree in the premises.
