

On the motion of James Bell administrator of Harrison Bell dec^d Ordered that William M Jones who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose de statu, and settle some account of said Harrison Bell's guardianship of Mary Amanda Belling and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Samuel Drury. Ordered that Master Commissioner Bell examine, settle and settle an account of the said Drury's administration on Adam Withers estate, and make report thereof to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or whomever he may be required to state.

John C Dunn who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer the Commonwealth of a certain felony of which he stands accused in slaying a negro man slave named Jacob belonging to Thomas Hanson appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance and was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County - Writings found on him were shown and examined, and the said Dunn by his counsel fully heard. On consideration whereof it is the opinion of the Court and accordingly ordered that the said Dunn be discharged from further proceedings for the said offense.

On the motion of Sarah D'Waley who made oath and together with Robert Feltton and Thomas F. Pothier his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of James D'Waley dec^d in due form.

Ordered that Joseph Feltton, W. L. Drew and Joshua Pothier being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of James D'Waley dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

The Court doth assign Joseph F. Pothier guardian to Adeline R. Bland orphan of Joseph F. Bland dec^d and thereupon she said Joseph F. Pothier with Sampson B. Ross and Edwin W. Bland his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned according to law.

Commissioner Barrett orphan of Parker Barrett dec^d with the approbation of the Court made choice of Jack Barrett for his guardian who together with Alexander Myrick and Mark F. Peck his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars with condition according to law.

Parker D. Story is appointed constable in the lower district of Saint James parish in this County in the room of Harrison P. Pope resigned; it appearing to the Court that said Story is a man of honesty, sobriety and good demeanor; and thereupon the said Story with John D. Riddle & Alexander Myrick his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars with condition according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said Story took the several oaths prescribed by law.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
