opinion of the Court and accordingly ordered that the said Burnell be discharged from further  
prosecution for the said offense.

Thomas J. Trotter his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of  
two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificat is granted him for obtaining  
letters of administration on the estate of James B. Bailey dec<sup>d</sup> in due form.

Ordered that Joseph Trotter, W. L. Drew and Joshua Phipps being first duly sworn  
before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do apprise all the personal estate of  
James B. Bailey dec<sup>d</sup> and return the apperment under their hands to Court.

The Court doth assign Joseph B. Prince guardian to Adeline R. Gland orphan of  
Joseph T. Gland dec<sup>d</sup> and therupon the said Joseph B. Prince with Sampson Oates  
and Edwin D. Gland his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of  
ten thousand dollars conditioned according to law.

Benjamin Barratt orphan of Parker Barratt dec<sup>d</sup> with the approbation of the Court  
made choice of Jack Marcell for his guardian who together with Alexander Myrick  
and Mark T. Peete his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of one thousand  
dollars with condition according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said boy  
took the several oaths prescribed by law.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
