We undersigned two of the Commissioners appointed in said decree in relation to the regulation thereof, being attended by Thos. D. Worrell as Surveyor, have laid off the dower of Mrs. Edwin Underwood, in the land of her late husband Frederick Boykin deceased, there being in the whole tract, by a former survey, Ninety one acres, of which we have laid off twenty four acres for the dower, including the houses, by a line beginning at a post oak, a corner for said dower, in Josiah Worrells line, thence along a new line of marked trees N 75 E 12 poles to a dogeared standing on the North side of the Adams branch thence N 75 E 42 poles to a small white oak, thence N 64 E 11 1/2 poles to a hickory, a corner for the back dower in Etheldred Smiths line, thence his line to Ferguson line, thence along said Ferguson line to said Josiah Worrells line, thence his line to the beg<sup>n</sup>.
