"We the jury find the defendants guilty and assess the fine of Randall ten dollars and Duvie five dollars." Therefore it is considered by the Court that the Commonwealth recover against the defendant Randall ten dollars and against the defendant Duvie five dollars the fines by the power aforesaid in favor of said plaintiff and the costs of this prosecution about the said defendants may be taken up.
