On consideration whereof it is the opinion of the court as the case appears to them that the said Henry P. Daff be discharged from further prosecution for the said supposed offence. And proclamation being made as the same is and nothing further appearing or being alleged against the prisoner it is ordered that he be forthwith discharged from custody.
