On the motion of Arrington Gardner who made oath and together with Hilles Boardman and William Dawson his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One hundred & dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Mary Stanley Stanley dec'd in due form.
