On the motion of Josiah Hany who made oath and together with Augustus W. Hart J. E. Mahone and Littleton R. Edwards his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of eight hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration de bonis non with the will annexed of William Holliman dec<sup>d</sup> in due form.

Ordered that Jesse Drury, Jacob Williams, James P. Holt and Thomas Ridley or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of William Holliman dec<sup>d</sup> and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that John B. Jenkins, Jordan Edwards and Mark Hault with the Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Isle of Wight let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the bridge the black water river near Franklin, near the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
