The Commissioners called over this day and their report which is in these words. According to a decree of the County Court of Southampton term 1844 over Henry Lindard and Cassius Bryant Commissioners appointed by the said Court to distribute the said land and negroes that Sally Pope formerly Woodard held as dowry in her husband John Woodard's estate have after giving proper notice of time and place, made sale of the said dowry land and negroes slaves on a credit of six months and after paying all costs do distribute among the legatees agreeable to said decree. As for the real estate we do assign one bond against Master Pope and others to Benjamin Norvell for thirty two dollars and 67/100 due 16th March 1845. Also one bond against Master Pope and others to Nathaniel Jones Esq. Mary Jones who was apportioner of the said Woodard for thirty two dollars 67/100 due 16th day of March 1845. One bond to Master Pope & others for thirty two dollars and 67/100 to John Simmons and wife Mary given to the discretion of the Court who is now residence. One bond to Master Pope & others to Cassius Bryant adm'r. of Samuel D. Woodard dec'd for thirty two dollars 67/100 due the 16th day of March 1845. One bond to Master Pope and others to William D. Clarke trustee for Daniel Self Esq. for thirty two dollars and 67/100 due the 16th day of March 1845. One bond to Master Pope & others to the heirs of Cassius Woodard for thirty two dollars 67/100 due 16th day of March 1845. and the other due to Master Pope & others to the heirs of Jesse Woodard for thirty two dollars 67/100.
