According to a decree of the County Court of Southampton April 1844 we Henry Lillard and Emma Bryant Commissioners appointed by the said Court to distribute the slaves land and negroes that Sally Pope formerly Woodard held as dower in her husband John Woodards wife heirs after giving proper notice of time and place make sale of the said dower land and negroes slaves to a credit of six months and after paying all costs to distribute among the legatees aforesaid to said decree. Vizt.
As for the real estate we do aforesaid in bonds against Master Pope and others to Jessie Pope Worrell for thirty two dollars and 6/100 due 16 March 1845. Also one bond against Jessie Pope and others to Nathaniel Jones Esq. Mary Jones also was aforesaid of the same Woodard for thirty two dollars 6/100 due 16 day of March 1845. One bond to Jessie Pope & others for thirty two dollars and 6/100 to John Simmonds and wife Mary given to the discretion of the Court who now reside. One bond to Jessie Pope & others to Emma Bryant adms. of Samuel B. Woodard decd for thirty two dollars & 6/100 due the 16th day of March 1845. One bond to Jessie Pope and others to William D. Clarke trustee for Daniel Falls for thirty two dollars and 6/100 due the 16th day of March 1845. One bond to Jessie Pope & others to the heirs of Emma Woodard for thirty two dollars 6/100 due 16 day of March 1845 and the other due to Jessie Pope & others to the heirs of Iggo Woodard for thirty two dollars 6/100.
