Richard Gray & Robert Searbrought for an affray by fighting together at Richard Gray's house in said County on the 12th Inst. by the information of Olisha Pope one of our body who was sworn in Court to give evidence.

Edwards Butts & Peter J. Adams for an affray by fighting in public on the road of Jerusalem in the County of Southampton on the 16th Inst. by the information of Edward Deaton who was sworn in Court and sent to the grand jury to give evidence.

Willie Griffin for feloniously stealing, taking and carrying away one pistol from William S. Williams by the information of the said William S. Williams who was sworn in Court and sent to the grand jury to give evidence, and

Baldy & Mountford & Matthew Mountford for an affray by fighting in public at the house of James S. Williams in said County sometime in the month of March last by the information of Alfred Ricks one of our body who was affirmed in Court and sent to the grand jury to give evidence. And the said grand jury having nothing further to present were discharged.
