And thereupon it is ordered that the said defendant be removed to jail.

Whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court the said motion is continued till the next term.

Ordered that Augustus W. Hart, William Dr. Nicholson and William S. Webb or any two of them do let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of the suspension bridge across the same when completed and make report thereof to the Court.
