John Avery is appointed Surveyor of the road from the forks of the road at Edward Harrison to Flat Swamp bridge in the name of Francis B. Jones ex-mill and it is ordered that the usual bonds do work thereon.

Joshua Crumpler is appointed Surveyor of the road from Franklin to the Cedar Swamp in the name of Edwards & Crumpler ex-mill and it is ordered that the usual bonds do work thereon.
