Anthony M. Howell and Richard Parker are unanimously elected in the lower district of Nottingham Parish. It appearing to the Court that the said Hays, Powell, Everett, Swann, Drury, Branch, Howell & Parker are men of honesty, probity and good demeanor.

On the motion of John W. Reese and Mark S. Dabie who make oath and together with C. B. Elwood and Thompson H. Reese his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted them for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Arthur B. Reese in due form.

And thereupon the said Benjamin Drury together with John M. Darling his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

William C. Williams is appointed Surveyor of the road from Allens quarter to Benn creek bridge in the road of John Dabie and it is ordered that the usual bounds be made.

The Court doth assign Martha M. Vaughan guardian of William S. Vaughan coheir of Anthony Vaughan whereupon the said Martha M. Vaughan with William Edwards & Matthew Wills her securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned according to law.

Ordered that the presentment of the grand jury this day made against Miles Sniffen be certified to a Justice of the Peace for this County to be proceeded on according to law.
