Griffen who is appointed as Commissioner for said Purpose shall to the highest bidder on the premises in a court of Justice make except cash sufficient to pay the costs of the suit and expenses of the sale, after giving twenty days notice of the name and place of sale, the sum of one hundred Dollars Vick did suege - that he take bonds out of security of the purchasees in three equal amounts and assign one bond to Mills C.
