On motion of Nancy Gardner. Ordered that William M. Jones who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose do make settle and adjust an account of Dr. S. J. King Gardner's administration on Samuel P. Gardner's estate and make report thereof to Court.

This day this cause came on to be heard by consent of parties on the bill and answer not as argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth order adjudge and decree that Alexander Myrick, Thomas W. Howell and Jacob Barrett be appointed Commissioners of this Court and that they divide the lands of William Bryant into four shares and sell no share to the heirs of Matilda Howell, one to the heirs of Martha Williams, one to Jonathan Darden and wife Dempsey, one to John E. Deale and wife Lydia and the other to Orman Bryant devisee of Angel Bryant. That they value said shares thus divided also value the lands of Davis Bryant, Orman Bryant, James Bryant, Benjamin Bryant and Herbert Bryant and report said valuation to the Court. That said Commissioners after said valuation sell to the highest bidder for each the negro slaves belonging to said estate and that out of the money arising from said sale, after paying the costs of the land, pay in the first instance to the heirs of Matilda Howell, the heirs of Martha Williams, Jonathan Darden and wife John E. Deale and wife and Orman Bryant the amount or amounts necessary to equalize the lands allotted to them in point of value with the new held as an advancement by Davis Bryant, Orman Bryant, James Bryant, Orman Bryant and Herbert Bryant. And they further divide the balance of the money so held, in two parts, and after severally take ten per cent above named. The Court doth further authorize said Commissioners to direct payment to be made to any one of the heirs, advancements, of said valuation. It should be found necessary to make all right also take into the valuation any other advancements other than lands that any one or more of the legatees may have received.

On motion of Davis Bryant. Ordered that Alexander Myrick, Thomas W. Howell and Jacob Barrett or any two of them, who are hereby appointed Special Commissioners for the purpose do make settle and adjust an account of said Davis Bryant's administration on William Bryant's estate and make report thereof to Court.
