On the petition of John Vick who made oath and together with James Vick and Benjamin Barlow his executor entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of eight hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration in the estate of Augustus M. Vick *de* in due form.

Ordered that John Vick John Scarborough Samuel Wells and Robert Riches or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Augustus M. Vick *de* and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Poyant his executor entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration in the estate of James C.
