Williams or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Polly Stephenson within this County which may be so found produced a bill and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that William L. Everett, John A. Price and Peter Edwards or any two of them do contract with some person for removing the raft from Hugley bridge forthwith and that said Commissioners do not with the Commissioners to be appointed by the County Court of Roanokeville in letting the repairs of said bridge remain the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

Accounts of N. P. Phillips guardian of Virginia E. Daniels to and Mary W. Ricks wife of Edwin Ricks were returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of John Vick who made oath and together with James Vick and Augustus Gardner his bondsmen endorsed unto and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of eight hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for drawing letters of administration on the estate of Augustus M. Vick deceased in due form.

Ordered that George Vick, John Gearbrough, Samuel Hills and Robert Ricks or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Augustus M. Vick deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of Elizabt J. Williams who made oath and together with Edwin A. Hicks and James D. Bryant his bondsmen endorsed unto and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for drawing letters of administration on the estate of James C. Williams deceased in due form.

Ordered that James D. Bryant, Lewis H. Cobl, Archibald Williams and John Moore & Co. or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of James C. Williams deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of Henry Riddle telling forth that he bound on the behalf of County for William D. Rockelle for his guardianship of Martha E. Rockelle and that he conveys himself to be in danger of suffering damages by reason thereof and praying of the Court for relief it is ordered that the said William D. Rockelle be summoned to answer the said motion whenever the said Rockelle appears and intimated yet due notice of this motion and the further hearing thereof it is ordered that the said Rockelle give the said Plaintiff good security
