This day this cause was conducted by leave of Court and consent of parties and came up to be heard on the bill and answer and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth order, adjudge and decree that Davis & Argant be appointed as Commissioners of this Court, that he after advertising the same and notice of sale to the highest bidder, upon a credit of nine months, except for his own costs as may be necessary to pay the costs of this decree, which he is to receive in cash. That he take out of the proceeds of said sale, all the just debts of his testator Williams Vick, and after the payment of said debts he shall pay over the surplus, if any, to the heirs at law of said Williams Vick. That he report to the Court in order to a final decree.

On the motion of Adolphus St. Jones who made oath and together with John W. Becket and Lewis Merrill his securities entered into and acknowledged as bond on the penalty of twelve thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, and offered as a guarantee for the payment of the said debts of said Williams Vick, and after the payment of said debts he shall pay over the surplus, if any, to the heirs at law of said Williams Vick. That he report to the Court in order to a final decree.

Ordered that Thomas W. Merrill, Robert L. Barnes, John W. Hart, Thomas Argant and Elizabeth Jones or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose, do appraise all the personal estate of Williams & Williams de' and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of John W. Mason. Ordered that one of the Commissioners of this Court examine, state and settle an account of the said Masons administration on Joseph Williams estate and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of John W. Mason. Ordered that one of the Commissioners of this Court examine, state and settle an account of said Masons administration on Richard A. Williams estate and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Thomas J. Drumright and Joseph B. Bailey render before a Commissioner of this Court an account of their administration on Rufus Hart estate and that the said Commissioner examine, state and settle the same and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of James Clayton. Ordered that William S. Goodenough who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose, do take and settle and adjust said Clayton administration on Elias Sumner's estate and make report thereof to Court.

Robert Pirelow is appointed surveyor of the road in the road of Williams & Williams de' and it is ordered that the usual bonds be made thereof.
