First day this cause was docketed by leave of Court and consent of parties and
cause to be heard on the bill and several audience argued by Counsel. It is considered
that if the Court doth order, adjudge and decree that David Bryant be appointed as
Administrator of this Court, that he after advertising the same and option of due time
to the highest bidder, upon a credit of nine months, except for demands made at any
time before to pay the costs of this suit, which he is to receive in cash. That he be
out of the proceeds of sale pay all the just debts of his testator William Vick, and
after the payment of such debts he shall pay over the surplus, if any, to the heirs &
law of said William Vick. That he report to the Court in order to a final decree.

On the motion of Adolphus H. Jones who made oath and together with Jacob
Bratt and Lewis Worrell his severities entered into and acknowledged as true and
penalty of twelve thousand dollars conditioned at the law courts, certified in
present sum for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of William E.
Williams deceased in due form.

Ordered that Thomas D. Worrell, Robert L. Morris, John D. Hart, Orman Pease
and Elzaphay Jones or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice
of the Peace for that purpose, do appraise all the personal estate of William E.
Williams deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of John M. Mason. Ordered that one of the Commissioners of the Court
examine, state and settle an account of the said Mason's administration on Joseph
Williams estate and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of John M. Mason. Ordered that one of the Commissioners of the
Court examine, state and settle an account of said Mason's administration on Richard
A. Williams estate and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Stevens J. Drumwright and Josep H. Bailey render before a Com-
missioner of this Court an account of their administration on Rufus Hart's estate and
order that the said Commissioners examine state and settle the same and make
report thereof to Court.

On the motion of James Clayton. Ordered that William T. Goddard be
so hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose, do state, settle and
adjust said Clayton's administration on Elias Lummerville's estate and make
report thereof to Court.

Robert Proctor is appointed Surveyor of the road on the road of William Vick
deceas'd and it is ordered that the usual bonds be worded thereon.
