more than 2 1/2 or 3 miles and would be the most direct road from Monroe to Suffield and  
Preston. The mode of opinion that it would be of no inconvenience to any individual as  
evidenced by the fact (as we have been informed by Mr. Vaughan) that all the land  
owners are willing to relinquish all their claims for damages. We are advised by Mr.  
Vaughan that should the Court grant the order to open it it shall not cost the County  
more than one hundred dollars. Given under our hands and seals this 8<sup>th</sup> instant

consideration thereof it is considered by the Court that the said motion be granted.
