

Allen Stephens is appointed guardian in person of the 23 in the name of William B. Hunt as executor.

John M. Barley and Samuel Ellis who have been appointed Guardians of the Poor in this County for the ensuing year this day severally gave bond with security according to law which bonds were acknowledged by the Clerks thereof and ordered to be recorded.

Donnell T. Driggs is appointed Guardian of the estate of Martha Driggs a person of sound mind and throughout the said Donnell T. Driggs with William J. Tobell and John Graham his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars, conditioned according to law.

This Court unanimously recommends Jacob Barnes, Josephus Rowden and Jeremiah Ellis to the Governor of this Commonwealth as fit and proper persons to execute the Office of Sheriff of this County the ensuing year.

Examen Spring is appointed surveyor of the road in the name of Alfred T. Stephens and it is ordered that the usual bonds be sworn thereon.

On the motion of Goodwyn B. Griffin who under oath and together with Robert B. Griffin and William B. Griffin his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs to be taken as provided him for taking letters of administration on the estate of Mills Herring dec^d in due form.

On the motion of John Vick, of James, he is exempt from the payment of taxes for his negro slave being in future the being aged and infirm.

On the motion of Edwards Parks executor of Henry Harrison dec^d he is exempt from the payment of taxes and duties for his slaves named Susan &c. in future they being aged and infirm.

On the motion of Samuel & John Drury. Ordered that Master James general bill returned State and debts and debts on account of their casual proceedings in Humphrey Drury's estate and on the report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Josiah Griffin Alfred T. Stephens, Jordan Spring and Benjamin Druggell or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Mills B. Herring dec^d and return the appraisement under their hand to Court.

An inventory and appraisement of the estate of Benjamin Lamb dec^d was returned and ordered to be recorded.

Benjamin Minter, Benjamin Drury, James Adams, Alexander Myrick, Charles Tappan, Benjamin Morris, William D. Reed, Thomas B. Morrell, Joshua Druggell, William B. Stephens, William A. Jones, Howell Harris and James Mages are appointed Special Guardians of the Poor in this County for the ensuing year and it is ordered that the Sheriff notify them of their appointment.
