negro woman Tabitha together with forty three dollars 75/100

To William & Williams was allotted negro man George the said William & Williams
paying one hundred and fifty six dollars 25/100 to Catherine S. Williams
and Penelope S. Williams in their respective proportions (1/2) to Catherine S.
Williams one hundred & thirty four dollars 25/100 and to Penelope S. Williams
the same of twenty one dollars 25/100

To Elizabeth Williams was allotted negro man William the said Elizabeth
Williams paying one hundred and fifty six dollars to Catherine S. Williams
& Penelope S. Williams in their respective proportions (1/2) to Catherine S. Williams
one hundred & thirty four dollars 25/100 and to Penelope S. Williams the
same of twenty one dollars 25/100

James D. Parker is appointed surveyor of the road from the railroad to the

is ordered that she must keep the work thereof
