This Commissioners in this cause this day made their report in these words to wit: "Approving to an order of Southampton Court made October 1845 the Commissioners proceeded to allot to Martha Briggs the Widow of Capt. William Briggs and one third part of the Lands of which lot had seized and estimated the quantity at three hundred and twenty four acres: The estimate of one third is also in consideration of that proportion which Capt. Briggs devolved to his son Bennett S Briggs bearing date 15th October 1844 and duly recorded the aforesaid share being bounded as follows: East by the Road leading from Brunswick North by the deep branch East by the said branch and Western branch and South by the Lands of Anselm B. Hargreave being such regular and natural boundaries: that the Commissioners thought proper to do away with the services of the surveyor who was thereat in attendance" all of which is respectfully submitted the 25th day of November 1845" M^{rs} Richardson Ex^{rs} Childs Edward A. Westbrook to his grand children the children of his deceased daughter Mary Harris in three equal parts regard being had to value and that they select by casting lots one of said shares and allot the same to William Harris and that they permit the other two shares to remain as if undivided in the hands of Soel Harris according to the direction of David Westbrook will be one of the other children arrive at age or marries then the said Commissioners are to divide said negro into two equal parts and allot one share to each of the two children and Report to the Court in order to a final decree.
