The Court doth assign William Diphrent Guardian to Katherine and Polly Johnson Daughters of Andrew Johnson. Whereupon the said Diphrent together with Thomas S. Barker and Alfred S. Diphrent his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

On Motion of James H. Bower
