This cause was this day docketed by consent of parties and with the assent of the court and cause set to be heard on the 1st and 2nd instant and was argued by Counsel on Consideration whereof the court did adjudge order and decree that William Braddock and Thomas H. Westbrook who are hereby appointed Commissioners for that purpose do divide the negro slaves of Nat Braddock &c in the 1st Ward of Newbern into five equal shares so as to allot to W. Braddock one fifth to Nat D. Braddock one fifth to Thomas H. Westbrook one fifth to A. Williams in right of his wife one fifth and to Robert A. Barnes in right of his wife Marinda one fifth but if division of the slaves in kind cannot be effected then the said Commissioners are hereby authorized to sell so many of the slaves a day or transpor to effect an equal division among the above named Negroes until last day shall have acted in the premises made Report to this court in accordance therewith
