On Motion of John Vick Ordered that one of the Commissioners of the Court examine state bills and adjust an account of said Vick Suretyship of the orphan of Edward Vick and not take receipt thereof to Court.

Ordered that John Vick be exempt from the payment of taxes for the next three years and next in future they being equal and equal.

Ordered that an inspection of facts be established for the County of Southampton and that the fee of inspection be that fixed by Law that a fee each year be paid and that an additional charge of two cents per line be allowed for speaking and copying to be paid by the owner of the facts whereupon John Williams was appointed inspector and thereupon he took the oath required by Law.
