

On the motion of Jonathan Darden guardian of the persons of John Wilson dec^d. Ordered that Henry Blow administrator of John Wilson render before a Commissioner of this Court an account of his transactions as administrator, and that the said Commissioner examine state and settle the same and make report to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

On the motion of Jonathan Darden administrator of Bennett R Whitfield dec^d. Ordered that he render an account of the said Whitfield's guardianship of Bynum & Penelope Whitfield before a Commissioner of this Court, and that the said Commissioner examine state and settle the same and make report to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

On the motion of Jonathan Darden administrator of Bennett R Whitfield dec^d. Ordered that he render an account of the Bennett R Whitfield's guardianship of the infant child of Elisha Whitfield dec^d before a Commissioner of this Court, and that the said Commissioner examine state and settle the same and make report to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Nicholson the sum of twenty seven dollars and twenty five cents the amount of his medical account proved to be just.

The Court doth assign James E Clayton guardian to James A & Mary C Prebow orphans of Sub Prebow dec^d and thereupon the said James E Clayton with Patrick Dole and James Clayton his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned according to law.

On the motions of Thurgas Lavin who made oath and together with James A Kello & William Joyner his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Benjamin Windham dec^d in due form.

The last will and testament of Jesse Norrell dec^d was proved by the oath of John H Landford and Susanna Barnes the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded, and on the motion of Jacob Barnes the executor therein named who made oath and together with Thomas B Norrell & Augustin Pope his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

Ordered that Bennett Barrett, Jonathan T Griffin, Nathaniel Jones and Asaph B Butler or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of James Norrell dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.
